

D. PROVISIONS REGARDING STUDENTS (Age 14-22)

1. Students can become FMMC Associate Members by submitting a completed membership form and paying student dues (see Section II.C.1).
2. Music students may become Performance Members through the standard FMMC audition requirements and procedures outlined in Section III. Students should consult with their teachers before applying for audition to be sure they understand level of performance expected.
3. The Club invites student competition winners to Solo or Composer Performance Membership without audition and awards complimentary membership as follows. At the close of the complimentary period, students can continue as Performance Members by paying dues.
 - a. National Symphony Young Soloists' Competition: finalists are awarded dues-free membership for the remainder of the current season plus the following year.
 - b. Joseph and Goldie Feder Memorial String Competition: first place winners in the Advanced category are awarded dues-free membership for the remainder of the current season plus the following year.
 - c. FMMC Student Competition prize winners and those awarded Honorable Mention: awarded dues-free membership for the remainder of the current season plus the following year.
 - d. Local residents who win national and international student competitions: awarded dues-free membership for the remainder of the current season plus the following year.
 - e. Johansen International Competition winners: awarded dues-free membership for five years.
4. Student Solo and Chamber Performance Members are encouraged to perform in FMMC's Student Recital series.
5. Students may perform in FMMC's public concerts on a space available basis as follows:
 - a. Solo Performance Members may perform in any subdivision of their discipline, and in chamber groups and the Chorale without further audition. Members who wish to be listed as performers in more than one discipline (e.g., piano and organ) must audition separately for each discipline (Section III.A.1).
 - b. Solo, Chamber, and Orchestra Performance Members may play in Avanti and or the Chorale orchestra at the invitation of the conductor or orchestra committee . (Section III.A.3.c.3).
 - c. Orchestra Performance Members are not eligible to play on other (non-orchestral) FMMC concerts except by special invitation. (Section III.A.3.c.3).
